OUTSTANDING MEMBER APPLICATION INFORMATION
14 -17 year old

To be considered as Westmoreland County Outstanding 4-H Member you are asked to submit an **application, a résumé based on the outlined criteria** and **two letters of recommendation for judging**. Members scoring in the top percentile of applicants will be invited to a personal interview. Application is based on documentation of life skill development; **understanding self, communicating, getting along with others, learning to learn, decision making/problem solving, managing, & working with groups**. Applicants in this recognition program:

- ✓ must be at least 14 years old and no older than 17 years of age as of January 1 of the current year
- ✓ must be in at least their third year of 4-H membership.

The written materials and the personal interview will be considered equally.
Applications will be due **August 1, 2008** in word format.

Evaluation Criteria

I. Application Form

- Neat and complete

II. 4-H Resume

In resume format, use the categories below to list your involvement, accomplishments, and skills you feel you have gained in the 4-H program.

Project Work: (*learning to learn, decision making, problem solving, managing*)

- Demonstrated a broad spectrum of project work
- Demonstrated a depth of educational project work
- Demonstrated a mastery of project work
- Participated in educational experiences based on project work i.e. (quiz-bowls, judging etc.)

Communication (*communicating, working with groups, problem solving*)

- Documentation of skill development with formal presentations at county, regional and/or state level.
- Served as a 4-H ambassador or spokesperson in their community.
- Documentation of skill development by serving in a communication role at club, county, regional or state level.
- Documentation of skill development by presenting an oral presentation on 4-H to a non 4-H group i.e. school, church, community service group etc.

Leadership (*working with groups, communicating, understanding self, managing*)

- Accepted and completed leadership roles at the club level
- Served as a teen leader or camp counselor that assisted younger members
- Served in a leadership capacity at the county, regional, state or national levels

Club or Group Experience (*working with others, getting along with others, managing*)

- Attendance at meetings
- Supportive of club functions
- Supportive of club financial needs
- Showed an appreciation for others

Citizenship/Service Learning (*getting along with others, making decisions, understanding self*)

- Demonstrated the member's willingness to give back to the community
- Demonstrated their willingness to give back to the 4-H Youth Program
- Served as a positive role model for 4-H

III. Letters of Recommendation

At least one letter of recommendation must be from a non 4-H related person (e.g. a teacher, employer, counselor, coach). Do not ask a member of your immediate family to complete a recommendation form.
